2023 ECoPP Work Plan

Work plan for 2023

- Sub-group work continues with review and finalisation of products
- Experts continue to oversee and monitor progress
- Organisation of occasional information sessions on relevant partnership themes for all ECoPP members.
- All members expected to participate in the design, development and review of the ECoPP products and make suggestions for their dissemination



1. Peer review process (Feb-June)

- Sub-groups will be paired in three groups to engage in a feedback process on their products and assist their finalisation
- Pairing process will be proposed by the partnership experts and draw upon the synergies and reflections discussed at the second ECoPP meeting
- Non-sub-group members will be invited to join peer review process by sharing their preferences for engaging with a particular sub-group theme
- Peer review process will involve virtual meetings to discuss and to ensure the finalisation of high-quality products



2. ECCP revision (Feb-June)

- Gathering and presenting concrete proposals for amending and updating ECCP
- Experts will work to refine amendments and submit them to the European Commission in June 2023
- Work will involve a group of ‘critical friends’ identified from the sub-groups as well as wider ECoPP members



3. Involvement of new members (May-Sept)

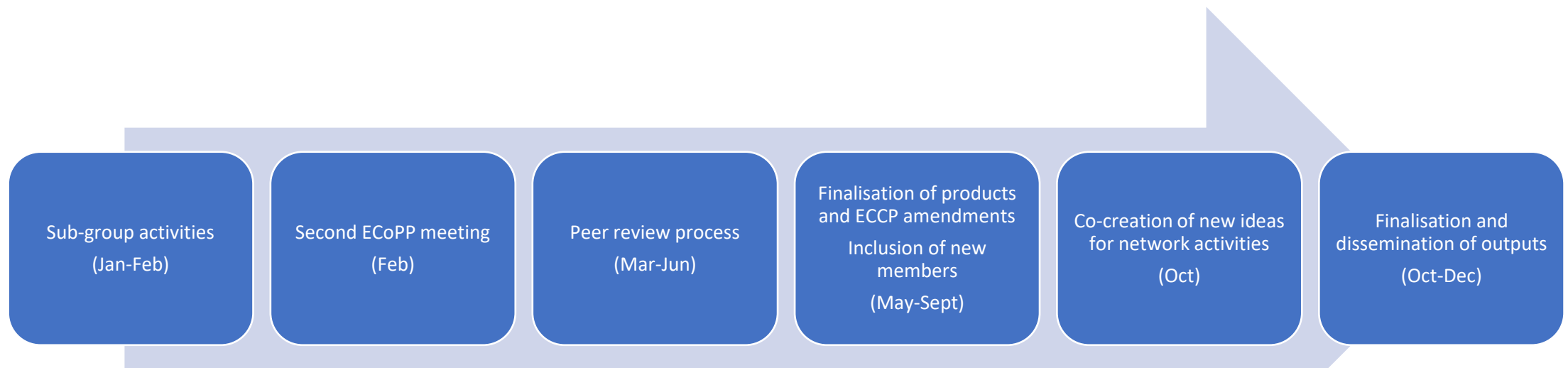
- Targeted call for new members based on analysis of current composition
- Selection process will aim to ensure balanced and comprehensive composition of ECoPP
- Experts will ensure new members are carefully briefed on the work of the ECoPP to date



4. New ideas for network activities and development of network products (Sept-Dec)

- Identify and agree on key topics and activities of interest for the network going forwards
- Development of ECoPP-wide products such as ECoPP Partnership Practices and an ECoPP Working Guide
- Sharing and reflecting on work to date and ideas for wider dissemination of relevant findings and lessons
